UNIFORM AND BADGE PLACEMENT GUIDE









PERSONAL CHALLENGE BADGES

Personal Challenge Badges are to be worn on the right hand sleeve. As new badges are earned, you should place them in rows across and then down the sleeve.

NAVAL/AIR RECOGNITION

TEAM CHALLENGES

SECTION BADGE

The Youth Section badge must be earned before it can then be worn here. Only one Section badge may be worn at a time. Rovers who are Leaders should wear the Rover badge and Leaders wear the Leader badge.

ZONE BADGE

After being invested you may wear your Zone badge here.

BOTTOM HALF

All members are expected to wear smart black trousers, shorts or skirt with this uniform.

SCARF AND WOGGLE

The scarf should be worn over the shirt collar and bound together using an appropriate woggle for your rank, Section and training (eg: PL).

GROUP BADGE AND NAME

If available, you may wear a Group badge or badge with your Group name on the back of your scarf.

CLUB/PACK/TROOP NAME

BRONZE, SILVER AND GOLD AWARDS

You may wear your Section's Bronze, Silver and Gold Awards together on your left hand sleeve as shown above (left to right).

SCOUT WINGS

NAME PLATE

YOUTH COURSES

(Sandford and Cossgrove)

AWARD PINS

Pins for Queen's Scout, DOE and St. George Awards may be worn next to the SCOUTS New Zealand logo.

WORLD SCOUT AND SCOUTS NEW ZEALAND MEMBERSHIP

The World Scout badge is incorporated into the SCOUTS New Zealand logo. The silver fern on the pocket represents New Zealand.

MORE INFORMATION

Leaders, Rovers and Venturers may also choose to wear a long sleeve shirt. There is also a three-quarter sleeve woman's cut available to purchase. Venturers and Rovers do not have Personal Challenge Badges but instead may choose to wear additional badges related to the Queen's Scout, BP and Duke of Edinburgh Awards at their discretion.

There are also alternative coloured shirts available for Sea and Air Scouts. Sea Scouts should wear the navy blue shown (the long sleeve is the Leaders version) and Air Scouts should wear the light blue shown. Sea and Air Scouts may wear their Naval and Air recognition badges whilst they are current.
